(Fixed Income) and Earnest Partners, LSV, Lyrical Partners and Clearbridge (Equities) for the month ending June 2019.
- 2. On a motion by Member Rivard and second by Member Downey, the BCRB voted unanimously to approve all other investment transactions executed in-house thus far for July 2019.
- 3. On a motion by Member Rivard and second by Member Downey, the BCRB voted unanimously to approve the Investment Summary Statement for month ending June 2019 as reported to the BCRB by our custodial bank (People's United); and a year-to-date performance.
